

FIELD TECHNICIAN DPW

The position is in the Wastewater Collection and Water Distribution Systems.

A variety of tasks are to be performed. Among these are:

- Check and maintaining wastewater lift stations
- Check water pumps and recording water pumped at the well houses
- Perform any maintenance and repair tasks as needed to keep systems in workable operation
- Read water meters
- Mark Miss Digs
- Mow grass/shovel snow
- Dig up manholes
- Operation of Vactor Truck and portable generators
- Collect water samples

With proper safety equipment a person must be able to enter manholes and wastewater lift stations. This requires some dexterity to climb ladders inside the manholes and wastewater lift stations.

Must be able to be “ON CALL.” and available for emergency situations.

Must have or acquire a CDL license. Must be willing to attend instructional training courses to acquire and/or renew MDEQ S-3, Waterworks System Operator certification. Some of the courses may be in the evening and/or out of town. The costs related for the courses will be paid for by the Township upon successful completion of any courses.

Will be required to maintain CPR and First Aid certificate for confined space requirements.

Must be able to read a map and mark water/sewer lines in the field.

Must be able to deal with the Public in a respectful manner.

Will be required to pass random drug tests.

The above statements are intended to describe the general nature and level of work being performed by people assigned this classification. They are not to be construed as an exhaustive list of all job duties performed by personnel so classified.
