Recycling fee applies on some electronics waste. Donations accepted to offset other collection costs.

ACCEPTED ITEMS

1. Household Hazardous Waste & Medical Waste (see list of accepted haz waste items below)
2. Electronics (computers, TVs, all electronics and appliances with a cord or that run on battery; recycling fee = \$5/computer monitor, \$10/TV, other items are free to drop off, cash/check due at event)
3. Magazines, Catalogs, & Books (soft & hard cover)
4. Shoes (all kinds)
5. Freon Appliances (freezers, refrigerators, window air conditioners, dehumidifiers)
6. Polystyrene/Styrofoam (blocks & food tray-type only; NOT soft foam, packing peanuts, or building material)
7. Eye Glasses
8. Bicycles
9. Document Shredding Service (free, on-site shred, households only)

ACCEPTED ITEMS Home, Garden, & Garage Chemicals: used motor oil & filters, gasoline, antifreeze, oil-based paint, stain, varnish, household & car batteries, yard chemicals, cleaners, paint thinner, unwanted pills and other medications, medical needles/sharps, mercury items, compact fluorescent light bulbs & fluorescent tubes 8 ft. & shorter, photo chemicals, pool chemicals, small propane cylinders, adhesives, driveway sealer & more.

Electronics, anything with a cord or battery, such as televisions (\$10 recycling fee), computer monitors (\$5 recycling fee), telephones, cell phones, DVD players, printers, appliances, window air conditioners, dehumidifiers, cameras, etc. Electronics will be recycled by Green Earth Electronics Recycling of St. Joseph, MI.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED tires, gas grill propane tanks, ammo, fireworks, waste from businesses, & latex paint (latex paint can be dried out and placed with regular trash, leave lid off the paint can - tips for drying latex paint at www.berriencounty.org/recycle)

FEE \$5/computer monitor, \$10/TV, donations are accepted and appreciated to help offset other collection costs.

Electronics Recycling

All electronics waste (TVs, computers, appliances, stereos, DVD players, phones, anything with a cord or battery) is made with recyclable materials, and some have hazardous materials in them.



In addition to the collection events listed above, there are many electronics recycling options available in Berrien County open year around. Call, email, or visit the website for a list of e-waste recycling options.
