

**NILES CHARTER TOWNSHIP

Public Hearing Geiger Park Light District #13 Expansion Assessment Roll: four property owners were present at the public hearing: Bill Alford, Jack Wright, Vincent Willemin, and William Riley. Bill Alford advised that he was not in agreement due to it is not an advantage for him to pay for a street light that will not benefit him. Jack Wright expressed his concern over paying for a street light for 30 years which he has paid for in excess of \$50.00 two times per year. Ringler advised that per his taxes he has been paying approximately \$26.00 per year on the winter bill due to special assessments are only on the winter bill and with the street light district that will decrease to \$13.53 per year. Vincent Willemin expressed that he doesn't live on his property on Riverwalk Drive so a street light really doesn't benefit him. After hearing the resident comments, Kidwell advised that the majority of Geiger Park property owners have petitioned and agree to a street light district due to several complaints regarding vandalism in the subdivision due to poor lighting.

Kidwell motioned to close the public hearing at 6:59 p.m. Kuehn supported the motion.
