SPECIAL MEETING**

Supervisor Stover called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. at the Township Hall, 320 Bell Road. Ringler led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Cooper, Eull, Hoese, Noble, Ringler, Stover, Vella.

Public Hearing-Determination Of Assessments For 2013: Stover presented assessments for 2013 follows: General Fund Assessment to be set at .8732 mills for a sum of \$308,951.18, Fire Operating and Maintenance to be set at 2.5 mills for a sum of \$813,151.48, Fire Capital Improvement Assessment to be set at .25mills for a sum of \$81,315.15, Street Light Assessment to be \$32,941.18 and the Berrien County Sheriff's voted millage to be set at 1 mill for a sum of \$353,814.91. The board discussed the deficit of the Fire Operation and Maintenance of which the General Fund has supplemented. The board also discussed possible resolutions to fixing the deficit.

Comments from the Public: Brad Pasternak had questions regarding the assessments.

Noble motioned to adjourn at 6:50 p.m. Hoese supported the motion.
