IV. Plan Review Required

V. Applicant Signature

Text block: Section 23a of the state construction code act of 1972... followed by a signature line and date field.

VI. Homeowner Affidavit

Text block: I hereby certify the mechanical work described on this permit application shall be installed by myself in my own home...

VII. Fee Clarification

Text block: Item #2, Residential Heating System: This item is used for the installation of a heating system in a new residential structure. Item #4, Residential Boiler: A residential boiler must be installed by a licensed boiler installer. Items #14 and #15, Tanks: A homeowner must own tank to install.

IX. Instructions for Completing Application

General: Mechanical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Mechanical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the **job location** and **permit number**.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**
